- Returning students may wear last year's leotard, but when purchasing a new leotard, please check the dress code
- ALL ballet classes wear pink tights and pink ballet shoes (ladies); white socks & black ballet shoes (men)
- Level III/IV must enroll in 2 classes per week to promote to Level V
- Level V enroll in 2 classes/week to maintain their Level V status, and must enroll in 3 classes/week once invited to pointe

22-23 Statement of Financial Responsibility (Signed upon enrollment)

IMPORTANT: The following information applies to each student enrolled in dance classes at Dancers' Workshop and the party(ies) responsible for the payments of his/her tuition.

1. Tuition is due at the beginning of each month. After the 20th of the month, late tuition will be automatically charged a **\$20.00 non-negotiable late fee. (This will be based on the date the payment is received in the office).**

2. A registration fee of **\$35.00** for returning students if paid in June or July (**\$45.00** beginning August 3, 2021) and **\$65.00** for new students will be assessed at the beginning of each calendar dance year.

3. Students of the Dancers' Workshop will be considered actively enrolled from the period beginning with the date of registration to the end of each session. Beginning and ending dates for each session are outlined on the schedule of classes.

4. **Students may withdraw at the end of any month. Written notification must be received in the office of Dancers' Workshop prior to the last month enrolled. Any student who simply stops attending without notifying the office in writing will be considered actively enrolled and will be billed for tuition as such until written notification is provided.**

5. Prorating of tuition for summer vacations, extended family emergencies, and other extenuating circumstances will only be considered on an individual basis and if written notification is provided in advance and approved by the Director. NO EXCEPTIONS!

6. The Information fee of **\$115.00** is due with or before the November payment. Participation is required for all students enrolled in class's ages 3 to Level VI and the fee may not be transferred or refunded. A late fee of \$10 will be added to any Information fee not paid by Nov. 30th. *Students must maintain regular class attendance in order to perform in our Information. Even if the Information fee is paid, a student will NOT be allowed to perform if they have missed classes and are not prepared.

7. NSF checks will be charged an additional \$35.00 fee. Cards may be used online.

8. **ALL MONIES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCES! This includes but is not limited to natural or man-made disasters, pandemics, or other mass-impact events that are not caused by The Dancers' Workshop. All financial decisions are at the sole discretion of the owners and will be reviewed on a case by case bases.**

Policies

1. The Lobby is strictly for staff, students, and parents with business matters for the office.
2. Dancers ages 3 through Level I/II should be accompanied to the porch by an adult 5 mins prior to class time. Older dancers should NOT be dropped off more than 15 minutes prior to the start of class. Students should be picked up immediately after class. A late fee of \$1.00 a minute will be charged after a 5-minute grace period.
